There are many tour operators who can plan the day for you, but be adventurous and hire a car or a scooter to explore the island at your own pace. The roads are well sign posted but if you do stray away from the route, Langkawi's hospitable residents are more than willing to point the way for you.

Located in the northwest of Langkawi is the Machincang Cambrian Geoforest Park, with 550 million years old rock formations and an ancient rainforest thriving with flora and fauna. Catch spectacular panoramic views of the islands in the archipelago from viewing decks up at Mount Machincang and experience a whole new dimension of the attractions below at the Oriental Village and the general Geopark area.

1 SKYCAB, SKYGLIDE & SKYBRIDGE

Enjoy a thrilling ride on the Langkawi Sky Cab to the Sky Bridge at the Machincang Cambrian Geoforest Park. The glass bottom gondolas gives you a 360- degree view of the rainforest below and at the Langkawi Sky bridge, 2,300 ft above sea level are spectacular views of the archipelago which will take your breath away.

2 SKYREX

SkyRex provides a dynamic and totally immersive experience that takes sensory and physical simulation to a whole new level. An adrenaline inducing adventure that will excite, thrill and enthrall in equal measures.

3 ART IN PARADISE

Located next to the Sky Cab terminal is a masterful creation of illusion in art. Beautiful artworks combined with 3D components create a fun and interactive display. Get the excitement of travelling back through time and play with massive creatures, or you can run, jump, crawl on the walls, and touch anything you see... it's a playground to interact with your creativity.

In between the Oriental Village and the Perdana Quay is Pantai Kok where several food trucks serve local Langkawi favorites. Try the island's famed Laksa or Mee Rebus and the cendol- a cold coconut milk based drink – a great quick local lunch.



Take a ride on the giant and colorful amphibious vehicle for a duck tour which starts at the Oriental Village. A slow ride passing along Pantai Kok beach to Telaga Harbour where it plunges into the water moving out of the marina to reveal beautiful views of the island with the mountain backdrop. Discover this beautiful cascade of seven waterfalls with cool mountain pools at the foothills of Mount Machincang. The trail to the falls passes through the ancient rainforest. Check out the glass-bottom deck here for an amazing view of the falls below.

Perdana Quay which overlooks the Telaga Harbour marina has a row of choice international restaurants ranging from Indian, Russian, Italian, Japanese, Spanish Tapas bar, cafes and other fine dining options. With table settings in the open on the deck makes this a good option to end the day.





Islands of adventure, islands of beauty, islands of fun! Discover exotic white sand beaches. Swim in an ancient legendary lake. Sail into the sunset on the Andaman Sea. Sun, sea, sand and much much more.

PULAU BERAS BASAH

The secluded, beautiful white sand beach here is ideal for a leisurely stroll. Take a cooling dip in the crystal clear waters or take a parasail ride over and above it all.



A speedboat ride away is this legendary island famed for its fresh water lake - the Lake of the Pregnant Maiden. Take out a kayak or stroll to the viewing deck to get a close look at the marble formations and plunge into the cool fresh water to cool off after.



A spectacular seascape with limestone rock formations, the island is home to one of Langkawi's raptors – the White Bellied Sea Eagles. Eagle watching here is the main attraction.



Head to Pantai Tengah close to the tour boat jetties for lunch. There are numerous restaurants and cafes to choose ranging from Indian, Malay, Chinese and International menus.



Board one of the cruise charters available in Langkawi and set sail in the Andaman Sea. The cruise will stop over for a dip in the open sea (subject to sea conditions) and catch a magnificent Langkawi sunset with an all-you-can-eat and all-you-can-drink menu.

A popular local restaurant that serves some of the freshest seafood you can get, right from its own farm. Great ikan bakar (grilled fish) selection.



These night markets are at different locations around Langkawi daily. It's a colorful part of the island's routine. You can get anything here from local delicacies, sweets, fresh food and vegetables to cheap household items and Langkawi souvenirs. Stalls start operating from 3 pm onwards.



Kuah has a selection of restaurants available. Recommended is Wan Thai Restaurant with a comprehensive menu. From Thai starters of Kerabu, a mixed salad with variety of condiments, the signature Tom Yam soup and other main dishes to their delightful range of desserts.

KILIM KARST GEOFOREST PARK

Kilim Geopark's terrain is predominantly limestone - karst. Millions of years of erosion have created a unique landscape of pinnacles, cliffs, caves and hills as well as the rich biotopes of the mudflats and the mangrove eco-systems - accessible only by boats. Book through your hotels or go to the Tanjung Rhu jetties.



PAYAR MARINE Paradise



A floating restaurant situated right above the reefs with a view of the life below. Seafood is their specialty.







Located at the Legend Park, 1 Malaysia Restaurant serves an assortment of Malaysian favorites.



3 DUTY FREE SHOPPING

Bargains abound in this buzzing corner of the island. Many stores have sprung up with a wide range of duty free items from household items, chocolates, spirits and local fashion. Popular outlets :

Jetty Point, Langkawi Fair, Saga Shopping Centre, Paradise Duty Free Centre, HIG Mall.



Take a leisurely stroll to where a giant sculpture of Langkawi's eagle symbol dominates park. The sunset at the harbor is a spectacular view not to be missed.



1 | PULAU PAYAR MARINE PARK

Situated 35 km southeast of Langkawi, about 1 1/2 hours by speedboat, this island gem is well worth the trip. There's great swimming, snorkeling, and scuba diving available for the intrepid adventurer and nature lover. Swim amongst the marine life and get adventurous feeding the sharks that live within the reefs close to shore.

Daily trips starts at 8am, 8 hr trip from Kuah Jetty or RLYC, Kuah. Online booking also available.

DAY 5 Museum

Get close to the land and to the people, to the culture, the traditions, the history, all of which go back hundreds, even thousands of years, and still resonate today. And while you're at it, sample the delicious local food!

GUNUNG RAYA

Gunung Raya is Langkawi's highest peak. At 880 m, enjoy a light snack from the Observation Deck as you survey an incredible 360° birds-eye view of Langkawi and the islands beyond.



Kota Mahsuri, or 'Mahsuri's Mausoleum', a shrine and museum in memory of the 19th century princess, and heroine of Langkawi's most famous and enduring legend.



Sample authentic Malay dishes at this traditional restaurant that specialises in cuisines from Kedah and the other northern states. Selection includes variety of fish and chicken dishes, highly recommended is their signature Kerabu Beronok, a spicy Malay salad made with sea cucumber.



Originally a centre for agricultural study and research, Mardi Agro Park is now a tourist attraction where you can go to learn all about local fruits and vegetables, how they are grown, sample the fruits in season and much more.



The Kelana Mas area of Kuah has a selection of seafood restaurants. Widely acclaimed by locals and visitors alike, the restaurants serve seafood prepared in a variety of styles and are guaranteed fresh from the morning's catch.

CAR RENTAL/HIRE

Roads in Langkawi are well signposted and in good condition so hiring a car for self-drive adventures is a good option. You will need to watch out for motorbike riders, the occasional water buffalo that may wander onto the road and wildlife crossing. It is recommended that you use a licensed and insured car rental company to prevent any unpleasant incidents in the event of an accident.

TAXI

Taxis are readily available and resort staff can make bookings for you. Taxis work on a fixed price basis and we recommend you check the rate card where your fare is quoted. Some taxi drivers speak English better than others and they can be useful for roundisland trips as they can show you many points of interest. Taxis can be hired from the airport, all hotels and from major attractions.
