When going for bird and butterfly watching trips in Malaysia, it is useful to be equipped with suitable essentials and equipment. Below are handy tips:

- · Engage bird and butterfly field guides, if you are not familiar with the bird and butterfly species in Malaysia.
- Binoculars are essential in all habitats and a spotting scope is useful near coastal areas
- · When visiting protected areas such as national parks, nature parks and wildlife sanctuaries, nothing is to be damaged or taken out.
- Always use a local guide when you are not familiar with any bird and butterfly watching areas.
- When trekking in the forest, find out and choose a trail that you can complete before dark
- · Always notify the authorities or someone especially if you are going on your own.
- Treat the forest with respect and humility.
