The Etymology of Langkawi

1. It was marked in ancient maps as Langka, Langa, Lansura and Langapura.
2. The name means reddish-brown eagle in colloquial Malaysia. There's a breath-taking landmark sculpture of an eagle at Dataran Lang (Dataran Lang) which makes for a great instagrammable moment.
3. Some believe Langkawi means "many beautiful islands" in Sanskrit.
4. There was speculation of the island's link to an old kingdom in Kedah known as Langkasuka.
5. The French general once traveled to the island to purchase pepper, recording it as "Lancahui".

THE FIRST GEOPARK IN SOUTHEAST ASIA

Langkawi UNESCO Global Geopark (LUGGp) is the only global geopark covering the entire archipelago of 99 tropical islands. Spanning 47,848 hectares, Langkawi can be found approximately 25km north-west of Malaysia on the Andaman Sea. A large portion of the island is made up of flat, plains accentuated by limestone ridges, forests, hills and mountains.

STARTER PACK

How To Get To Langkawi



By Flight

Hopping on a flight to Langkawi is the easiest and fastest way to get there. Just book a flight directly to Langkawi International Airport is located at the south-western part of the island. There are no public buses or trains in Langkawi, you will need to either hop on a private transfer or book a taxi/ e-hailing service upon arrival.

- Singapore <=> Langkawi: 1 hr 25 mins. ±
- Penang <=> Langkawi: 35 mins. ±



By Ferry

An alternative would be for you to drive up to Kuala Kedah or Kuala Perlis for a ferry ride to the island. The journey from these locations to Langkawi typically takes about 1 hour depending on sea conditions.

By RO-RO Ferry

If you enjoy traveling in your own personal vehicle, the process is completely hassle-free. Online booking must be made 3 days before the date of travel with full payment. RORO ferry provides service transporting wheeled vehicle and passenger. Make sure you are well prepared with all the necessary documents before heading to the entry point at Kuala Perlis Terminal.

Getting Around Langkawi



Taxis

Getting a taxi is a convenient way to get around, taxis operate on a fixed rate depending on the distance.

If traveling as a group, book for a Langkawi Taxi Van with an experienced English / Arabic speaking driver is certainly your first choice.

Car Rental

The most convenient and cost-effective way of getting around Langkawi is to rent a car. Being a small island, a typical drive from end-to-end will usually take 30 minutes. In Malaysia they drive on the left hand side. Remember to always bring your driving license, valid credit card and additional proof of identity (such as a passport if you are hiring abroad).

E-hailing Apps

Fret not if you prefer to rely on the all-too-familiar e-hailing app. Grab and MyCar are the two most popular apps in Langkawi although other e-hailing companies are already making headway in this popular tourist destination.

Motorbikes & Scooters

Not only are motorbikes and scooters cheaper than renting a car, they're fun, convenient, and a common way to get around. They're so common that they are not strict on the license front although wearing a helmet is a requirement.

Bicycle Rentals



Although most motorbike and scooter rental outlets have bicycles for rent, you can actually book them ahead of time via online sites like Bikago, Klook, Veltra, or Book2wheel. Paddling across the beautiful landscape on an e-bike is another exciting option!

6. Drive with caution to avoid road accidents, and LOOK OUT FOR CROSSING WILDLIFE.
7. Avoid crowded areas and follow Covid-19 prevention measures.
8. Go Cashless. Adapt to the new norm can help reduce Covid-19 risk.

Please Don't:

1. DON'T LITTER! – especially plastic bags and bottles.
2. Don't alter, destroy or move plants, nests, shells, limestone or corals.
3. Don't disturb animals (or other nature lovers).
4. Don't feed the animals – they know what's healthiest for them!
5. Don't try to pet animals (especially monkeys!).
6. Don't buy ANY seashells or coral products, as this only encourages unsustainable practices.

Weather

Langkawi's daily weather is mostly sunny with temperatures varying between 30°C - 35°C, and between 28°C to 29°C at night. With accommodating climate all year round, you can plan your beach vacation any time you like.

Travel Adapter

Malaysia uses the G plug type, which has three rectangular pins arranged in a triangular pattern and operates on a 240V supply voltage and 50Hz frequency.

Language

Malay is the national language of Malaysia, used in official ceremonies and documents. English is the second official language of the country, and most Malaysian can speak English fluently. Other major languages spoken are Chinese and Tamil.

Mobile Pack

The best and cheapest way is to get a prepaid SIM card. Service and sales counters can be found at the arrival hall of Airport and jetty as well as convenient stores.

Culture

The majority of the island's population is Muslim, as such please keep your attire modest especially when visiting traditional / religious attractions. Please refrain from wearing revealing clothes unless you're at the beach.

Money changer and ATMs are located at the airport and jetty, Kuah town, Pantai Chenang and most shopping malls.

CHAPTER 1 Conservation Area

Langkawi is a geologist's treasure trove and a history book of the earth's formation. In 2007, Langkawi was awarded the UNESCO Global Geopark status, the first Global Geopark in Southeast Asia. Within the 47,848 hectares of land in Langkawi, established as the oldest landmass in Malaysia, are found more than 38 geosites of outstanding value that require protection. Currently, only three geoforest parks and a biogeotrail have been fully developed, namely Machinchang Cambrian Geoforest Park, Kilim Karst Geoforest Park, Dayang Bunting Marble Geoforest Park. These Geoparks and Kubang Badak BioTrail are designated to promote not only geological heritage, but also biological heritage and cultural heritage, which are very crucial for maintaining a healthy and sustainable environment. Nature's treasures takes you on a tour of natural wonders and artifacts from a bygone era.

Step Back In Time at Langkawi Geoforest Park

1 MACHINCHANG CAMBRIAN GEOFOREST PARK

Machinchang Cambrian Geoforest Park, located in the northwest of Langkawi Island, is the oldest clastic sedimentary rock at the age of 550 million years old. It features barren rocky peaks, stunning sandstone cliffs, and deltaic to shallow marine deposits that depicts the changing environment that denotes its age and history. Be on the lookout for cross-beds, ripple marks, ancient burrows, telling footprints as well as body fossils of ancient animals and plants.



Machinchang Rainforest

Machinchang is Malaysia's oldest mountain range, probably the most ancient rainforest on the planet. It's mountain peaks are carved by weather and time and is where you will also find lush ancient forest and perpendicular cliffs. These are the factors that make Machinchang Cambrian Geoforest Park so unique, you shall come to know the true magnificence that awaits you!

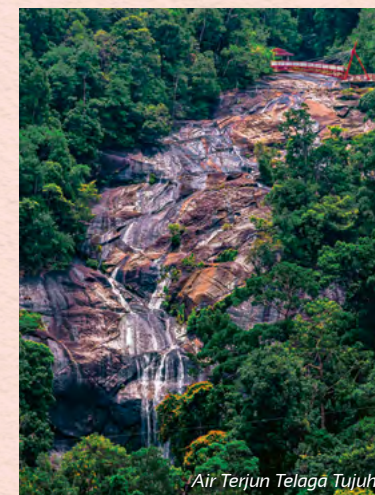

i. Air Terjun Telaga Tujuh

📍 6.3778, 99.6740

The waterfall's namesake comprises of 7 pools of various depths, shapes, and sizes, these pools are connected by a river and form a 91-metre-high waterfall, this natural wonder is one of the island's most revered and majestic attractions. Be rewarded with the sights of magnificence while immersing yourself in nature's infinity pool. Adventurous tourists can try the steep 45-minute climb up to the top of the waterfalls, be sure to look out for macaques, hornbills, and giant squirrels often found within the area.

ii. Pantai Pasir Tengkorak

📍 6.4308, 99.7259

This geosite is located on a rocky shore in the northern part of Langkawi, stretching from Pasir Tengkorak to Tanjung Buta where the old continent was submerged and features sedimentary structures showcasing crucial evidence of the sedimentary deposition process of the Machinchang Formation that occurred in deltas and coastal environments during the Cambrian Period (550-505 million years).

iii. Gunung Machinchang

📍 6.3870, 99.6611

Mount Machinchang is the second highest peak found on Langkawi in 708m above sea level. The resistance of the rocks against the tectonic deformation of the ancient sandstone mountain, which rose from the sea hundreds of millions of years ago, looks like it was chopped off. A four hour hike up to the peak rewards you with a breathtaking panoramic view of Langkawi.

iv. SkyCab

📍 6.3719, 99.6710

Starting off your journey at the foothills of Machinchang mountain, the breathtaking ride hovers over ancient sea and estuary before coming to the intermediate cable car station at the 650m above sea level meters mark. After enjoying the panoramic views of the many surrounding stations, take a short walk up to the Top Station for a view of deep chasms, cliff walls, isolated pinnacles, and Southern Thailand.

v. SkyTrail

📍 6.3714, 99.6717

There are three different paths to take with the starting point being Oriental Village at the Cable Car's base station. The easiest trail stretches 900m long and can be completed in 45 minutes while the intermediate trail features a 1.3km trail which will take approximately 2 hours and 15 minutes to complete. For a more intense experience, sign up for the extreme trail which measures 2.2km long and involves a 3 hour and 30 minute uphill hike. Service counter is located next to the Cable Car ticket counter at the base station in Oriental Village.

vi. SkyBridge

📍 6.3861, 99.6622

The journey along the curved bridge starts with either a cable car ride up to the top station and a ride on an inclined lift called the SkyGlide, or a 10 to 20 minutes steep mountain track up to the SkyBridge. Langkawi SkyBridge is one of the world's longest curved suspension bridges, it connects two hilltops of Mount Machinchang, the 125m long and 1.8m wide bridge maximises the viewing experience by providing a shifting perspective of its surroundings. Admire the ancient Machinchang Cambrian Geoforest Park with its exquisite geological and biological assets before looking out other districts.

KILIM KARST GEOFOREST PARK

Stretching across at 4,354 hectare, the Kilim Karst Geoforest Park is home to lofty limestone rock formations rising majestically over the river bed and awe-inspiring mangrove forests millions of years old. You will fall in love with the wide spectrum of geological wonders such as encapsulating caves, coastal and island karst morphologies, old fossils as well as lush mangroves filled with a variety of flora and fauna.

Witness Langkawi's secret fascinating wetlands and gorgeous limestones up close and personal, enter and explore the enclaves of Gua Kelawar & Gua Buaya, and then enjoy a hearty lunch at a floating restaurant along its pristine waters and stretches of beach perfect for swimming and fish feeding activities.

i. Mangrove Tours

It is the only place in Malaysia where coastal karsts and mangrove ecosystems co-exists today. Scattered across the geoforest are breathtaking limestone formations like Temple of Borobudur, Elephant Stone, and Hanging Gardens while the magnificent stalagmites and stalactites in the Gua Buaya, Cave of Legends, and Gua Kelawar await. The best way to see it is a leisurely boat ride along the tranquil Kilim River.

ii. Fish Farm

📍 6.4170, 99.8627

During your cruise, right across fleets of yachts, there is a small unassuming floating restaurant next to a fish farm. Floated simply by wooden platform on drums with a few water tanks to showcase the wide variety of local fishes, you'll get to choose your fish of the day, have it cooked and ready for lunch!

iii. Eagle Watching

The Langkawi landscape is an ecosystem that nurtures Brahminy Kites, the symbol of the island. Take a boat cruise along the river, you'll soon spot the bird's plumage colour spotting the sky. The bird of prey is also easily recognised by its white head and chest. Spotting these handsome Brahminy Kites remains one of the highlights of your trip.

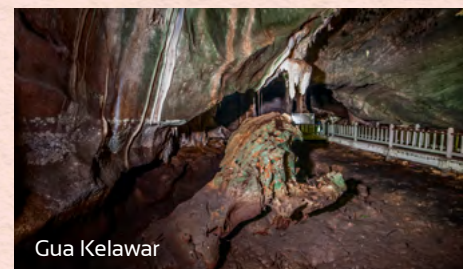

i. Gua Kelawar

📍 6.4022, 99.8589

"Kelawar" means bat in Malay, so there should be no surprise as to the highlight of this cave. A footbridge goes through the cave system that houses Malaysian fruit bats hanging aloft in the cold, dark cave. Nestled amidst the mangrove swamps of Sungai Kilim, northeast of the island, it is accessible via Tanjung Rhu Jetty by a 90-minute boat ride.

ii. Gua Cherita

Known for its mythological story of Battle of the 'Battle of Big Birds', Gua Cherita consists of two caves that sit quaintly on top of one another facing the sea. Inside, there are old Arabic inscriptions, more mythical stories and ornate stone formations. Take a boat from Tanjung Rhu or Kilim Jetty; there are lots of boatmen offering deals to get you around.

iii. Pulau Anak Tikus

📍 6.43279, 99.8933

This island was formed by the lower layer remnants of the Setul Formation consisting of limestone aged during the Ordovician to Devonian period, which is very rich in fossils, particularly gastropods and cephalopods. Take a boat tour to explore this fossil isle, for those who are lucky enough, you might even see the Indo-Pacific Humpback Dolphins in these waters.

iv. Pulau Langgun and Tanjung Dendang Geosite

📍 6.43279, 99.8933

It's all about bays, beaches, caves, hills, islands, forest reserves, streams and straits at Pulau Langgun and Tanjung Dendang Geosite. They feature important geosites on stratigraphic sections and fossils, as well as high ancient sea levels and a few coastal arctic sea arches and sea caves. Untouched and uninhibited, there is a breathtakingly beautiful lake in the middle of the island for all to enjoy.

3 DAYANG BUNTING MARBLE GEOFOREST PARK

A 20-minute boat ride from Pantai Tengah, the Geoforest features a medley of marble and limestone formations, mysterious cave systems, natural sea stacks and wave-related natural creations. The uniqueness is its beautiful marble limestone, which has undergone transformation induced by heat and pressure around 250 million years ago. Most tourists trek their way past the jetty and into the magical fresh water lake where the Pulau Dayang Bunting or Isle of the Pregnant Maiden is surrounded by lush rainforest and towering hills.

The second largest island in the Langkawi archipelago, the UNESCO Global Geopark features an extensive lineage of biodiversity and marble rock formations. Dating as far back as hundreds of millions of years ago, you can take a sail around the formations from the island's northern jetty to spend the day learning about the one-of-a-kind marble rock and terra rosa formations.

i. Pulau Dayang Bunting

Surrounded by mangrove trees and a limestone formation, the freshwater lake has very little to non existing levels of saline, hence, there is no added buoyancy when you swim in it. This scenic recreational park also is great for kayaking and paddleboats. A small shop aside offers drinks, snacks and souvenirs as well as life jacket rentals. Adventurous travellers can opt for the private tour via jet-skis where they can explore island for up to four hours.

ii. Pulau Tuba Mangrove Forest

Pulau Tuba, one of Langkawi's 3 populated islands, features Langkawi's traditional fishing village history. The best place to view the twisted and stacked rock patterns and unique forest is at Bukit Kechil. The island is great place for homestay experiences and nature lovers as cave-exploring and jungle-trekking and bird-watching especially hornbills.

KUBANG BADAK BIOGEO TRAIL

The Kubang Badak BioGeo Trail is one of the best places to witness the geological with cultural history of Langkawi. This unique tidal river estuary ecosystem is located in the west of Langkawi, it is covered with untouched mangroves and has a distinguished cultural history and early settlement history of the Thai community. There are 13 interesting sites to visit in Kubang Badak, take a boat to explore the mangrove, or go on a bird watching trip to seek shorebirds and mangrove birds, you decide.

i. Pulau Kubang Badak

This small island located in front of the fishermen jetty of Kampung Kubang Badak and covered in young mangrove forests.. Pulau Kubang Badak is very important, as it protects the fishing jetty of Kampung Kubang Badak from soil erosion, strong winds and waves from the open sea. There is no better way to experience Kubang Badak than on a relaxing Mangrove Tour, cruise down the calm, winding river, you can enjoy the fresh air found in this pristine mangrove forest.

ii. Kampung Siam & Charcoal Kiln

During the 18th century, the charcoal chamber site located in Kampung Siam was once a source of income for the Siamese community around Kampung Kubang Badak. Early settlers here were people of Thai ethnicity, some of the cultural heritage still found are the remnants of the charcoal making industry found are believed to be over 100 years old. On this three hour boat ride along the Siam River, you will be taken to Bukit Menora's Burning Chamber, Malaysia's oldest cave – Gua Pinang and experience crab catching at mangrove crab rearing farm.

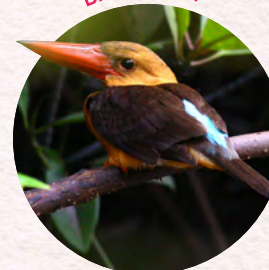

The islands are also perfect for those who like swimming in the crystal clear freshwater lake, historical and cultural buffs can also enjoy Malay villages and its surroundings. Other popular activities around the island include seafood hunting, jungle trekking, and cave expeditions.

1 Air Terjun Durian Perangin

This unexpected beauty is less crowded even during peak season and features beautiful, well-kept gardens along the way up to the main waterfall. Groups can enjoy a tranquil day-out swimming while making use of the huts as shade from the elements.

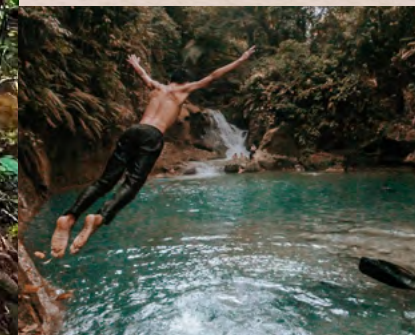

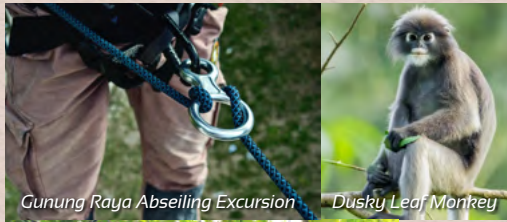
As one of the best waterfall hikes in Langkawi, Air Terjun Tama is hidden on an island which need a 20-minute boat ride from Jetty LKIM Kuala Chenang, Jeti Nelayan Perdana Quay or and Kubang Badak Jetty. Hike to the top of Langkawi's tallest waterfall will takes about 30 to 45 minutes, it can be intimidating, be sure to wear proper shoes, as the hiking trail can be slippery and rocky. Leapt into the turquoise swimming hole, take a dive into the deepest watering holes in Langkawi. Air Terjun Tama can only be accessed if you sign up for a local package tour.

Standing mighty and tall at 881 metres, hiking enthusiasts can conquer the mountain's via road or by climbing 4,287 steep steps, called Tangga Helang Seribu Kenangan. It is the highest mountain of Langkawi, experience it's impenetrable rainforest habitat, formed atop the 220-200-million-year-old granite foundation. Surrounded by dense forest reserves, be sure to catch sight of or take pictures of dusky leaf monkeys, flying foxes, macaque monkeys, great hornbills and more here. The duration of trek up to the top will take between 1½-2 hours, coming down takes half the time.

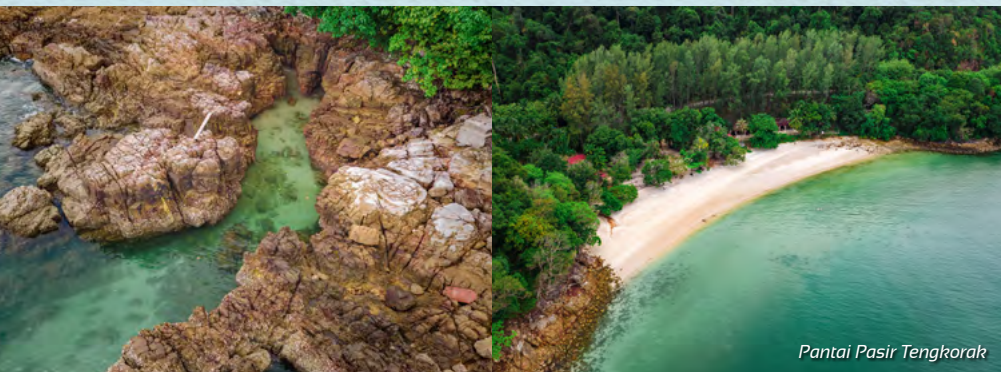

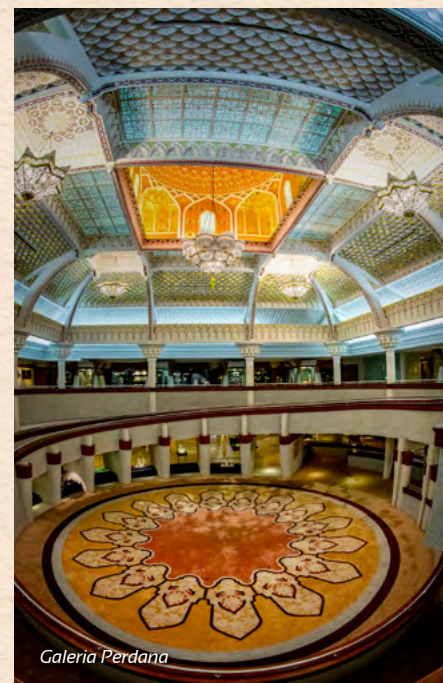

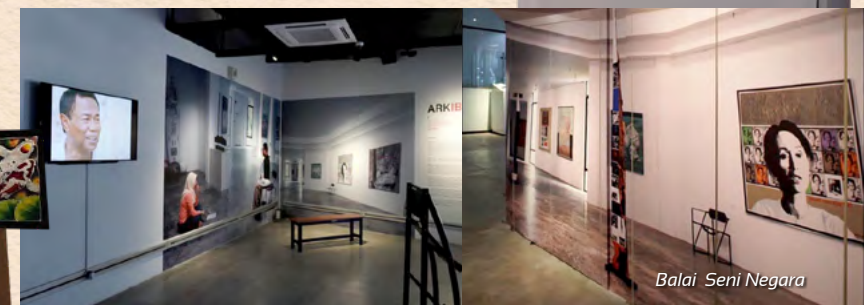

Traditional Cuisine and Delectable Eats



1 Gulai Panas

Gulai Panas is a spicy and hot curry. If you love spicy food, make sure you don't miss this wholesome traditional Malay cuisine. Unlike thick and rich traditional curries, Gulai is more tangy and watery. Served hot, it's delicious when drenched over rice and best eaten with sambal belacan and ulam-ulaman (traditional vegetable salad). You'll definitely be back for more.



2 Laksa

An explosion of taste, this spicy rice noodle dish is not-to-be-missed when you're in Langkawi. Its appetising and pungent broth is made with mackerel and aromatic herbs. There are many variations of laksa in Malaysia, and the key ingredient of Langkawi laksa is tamarind which gives the soup a distinctive tangy taste. It's topped with half hard-boiled egg, garnished with thinly sliced cucumber, lettuce, pineapple, onion, mint leaves and chillies.

4 Laktud

Boasting with medicinal benefits, Laktud is a form of seaweed that grows a fair distance from the shore. As it's seasonal you can't always get it during off seasons. It is said to reduce your cholesterol, provide overall well-being with its wound-healing properties and much, much more.



3 Sup Gamat

Gamat is Langkawi's Ginseng of the Sea! This sea cucumber soup is one of the most unique Langkawi delicacies, boasting with healing properties and an irresistible taste! With diced sea cucumbers boiled with a host of herbs, the soup has long been used as traditional medicine by the locals.



5 Bronok

A unique, delicious, and addictive salad often eaten raw, the bronok (a type of sea cucumber) is sliced and then mixed with coconut condiments, sambal, chili, kerisik, lengkuas, and shredded cashew leaves. This signature appetiser tastes salty, chewy and crunchy at the same time, it is a must-try dish that can only be found at Langkawi.



7 Mee Ketam (Crab Noodle)

It is one of the most popular dish in Langkawi. Scrumptious gravy simmered with crab shells for hours gives you a classic essence of the sea. The yellow noodle is topped with fresh flower crabs and served in sweet potato-based gravy along with a generous squeeze of lime juice. Letting these succulent flower crab meat melt in your mouth can be incredibly rewarding, you'll certainly be yearning for another plate! Although Mee Udang (prawn noodle) is more popular in Malaysia, however Mee Ketam is far more superb than anything!



6 Seafood

Langkawi is a uniquely seafood-centric island, blessed with an abundance of rich fishing grounds, seafood lovers can expect to find a vast array of fresh catch selections around the island at moderate prices.
